  - a. PAC Chair update 2 minutes
    - New Executive Role voted on at the Executive meeting Brit Boyd for Past Chair role.

      - Earthquake waters have been replaced in early September
  - b. Treasurer Report Ryan
    - update on signing authorities Brit is the approver
    - Teacher Allocations- paid an extra \$200 to missed class and \$200 to primary music.
    - -\$7000 from gaming grant money deposited last week-this is used for free school events open to everyone, welcome back BBQ, Pancake Breakfast.
    - -\$1000 given to Community Schools every year from gaming grant to fund breakfast program and sandwich program

    - -petty cash \$164

  - -winter concert dates TBD as we are trying to work around the Family First Christmas project in the gym.
