As we move through both processes we are exploring what ethics means to us and how this definition shows up in the work of our board. - SD46 has entered into a partnership with School District #48, Sea to Sky, and together we have received a grant to offer a dual credit Early Childhood Education program to grade 11 & 12 students. This program will offer a clear, accessible career pathway for senior secondary students. Students will be further supported by the ability to do practicums in SD46 Strong Start and Seamless Day childcare programs.
