Pack In/Pack Out: Due to the current situation of our local landfill reaching its capacity, the regional district has had to implement restrictions on the types of waste that can be sent to the landfill. Waste containing organic or recyclable items will either be rejected, or schools may incur financial penalties. Beyond the financial implications, it is also our social responsibility to limit our contribution to the landfill and strive towards more sustainable waste management practices. We have started implementing a process where students and staff will be bringing home what they bring to school.
